

SUMMER NIGHTS THROUGHOUT AUGUST FOR WEST MIDLAND SAFARI PARK



West Midland Safari Park will be open late every evening throughout August for their **SUMMER NIGHTS** event, following a successful 10 day trial last year.

Summer Nights will start on Friday, 1st August and end on Sunday 31st August and has been introduced to coincide with the annual main holiday period.

Gates to the attraction will re-open for the evening earlier this year - at 4.30pm - and visitors will have the opportunity to visit the animal reserves; the Park' Discovery Trail which includes all-weather attractions, namely Twilight Cave, Creepy Crawlies, Seaquarium and Mark O'hea' Reptile World, which incorporates the Record Breakers Exhibit housing some of the deadliest and largest snakes and reptiles from around the world. There will also be a Peter Pan Sealion Show performed each evening from the Sealion Theatre arena.

The Amusement Area will be open late with a variety of rides available, which include **VENOM, BLACK FLY AND TWISTER**.

The last admission time to **SUMMER NIGHTS** is at 7.00pm and admission costs £5.50 per person. Amusement rides charged extra.
