Guidance Notes

Application to register as a service voter

Please make sure that you complete Parts 1, 2, 3 and 5 of the form in full, otherwise your application may not be accepted. If you wish to arrange for a postal vote to be sent to you, or to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf, then you should also complete Part 4. If you are renewing an existing Service Declaration with this authority and have a postal or proxy vote already in force, then that will remain in force unless you provide new details in Part 4 or tell me that you no longer wish the arrangement to remain in place

Once your application is received we will write to you to confirm the details, and you will be registered for one year from the date on which your registration becomes effective.

The Two Versions of the Electoral Register.

The Electoral Registration Officer makes and keeps two versions of the electoral register - the full register and the edited register. Please put an X in the appropriate box on the enclosed form if you wish for your name and address to be excluded from the edited Register.

The full register lists everyone who is entitled to vote. You can check it by calling at the council offices or at some local libraries. Only certain people and organisations can have copies of the full register, and they can only use it for specified purposes. These include electoral purposes, the prevention and detection of crime and checking your identity when you have applied for credit. The law says who can have a copy of the full register and what they can use it for. The full list of such persons and purposes is given in the Representation of the People (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2002. It is a criminal offence for them to pass it on to anyone else or to use it for any other purpose.

The edited register leaves out the names and addresses of people who have asked for their names to be excluded from that version of the register. The edited register can be bought by anyone who asks for a copy and they may use it for any purpose.
