



Audible Intruder Alarms

Important Information

Did you know?

Noise from a burglar alarm could constitute a statutory nuisance under the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and as such, we have rights to silence the alarm if it is causing a nuisance?

If the alarm is not silenced within 20 minutes, we can get a warrant from a Magistrate to gain access to your home to switch it off. The costs of the work carried out can be charged to you, the occupier.

What do you need to do?

- Check that your alarm is fitted with a 20 minute cut-out device.
- Arrange for local friends or relatives to act as keyholders who will be able to access your property to silence the alarm. We recommend that at least two other people other than yourself should be nominated.
- Notify us with details of keyholders, by completing the form overleaf and sending it to us. Don't forget to let us know if your keyholder's details change. We will need to have not only their home address details, but also business details.
- You should also make sure your alarm system is regularly serviced.
